



NOTICE OF RACE Europa Cup 2022

Class Olympiajollen

16.08.-20.08.2022 UYCNs; Lake Neusiedlersee

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2 The 'Rules for Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding will apply.
- 1.3 Racing rule(s) will be changed as indicated in the NoR. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may change other rules as well.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.6 The regatta activities must be performed in accordance with the provisions on contrast and containment of the diffusion of COVID 19 issued by the Federation that the Organizing Committees will activate and to which the participating members must comply under the supervision of the Organizing Committee itself. Any cases of COVID 19 that should be detected during the event will be reported by the Organizing Committee to the competent health bodies in charge.
- 1.7 Appendix P (direct judging) will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising and bow numbers chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Olympiajolle Class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration via the internet link of the homepage from the UYNCS at: <u>https://www.uycns.at/uycns/regatten</u> and paying the required fees.
- 3.3 Late entries will be accepted.
- 3.4 Each competitor shall be a member of a club affiliated to his national authority of World Sailing.
- 3.5 Registration is open until the 31st of July 23:59 h.

4 FEES

4.1 The required registration fee is €150,- and shall be paid by bank transfer to:

4.2 After the 31^{st} of July the late entry fee will be $\in 30$,- extra on top of the registration fee.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration and mesurment is open from 14:00h till 18:00h on the 16th of August and from 08:30h till 11:00h on the 17th of August. At registartion competitors shall show there measurment certificate.
- 5.2 The first warning signal for the first race will be on Wednesday 17th of August at 13:00h





6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate. In addition equipment may be inspected or measured.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after the 16th of August on the notive board in front of the race office.

8 VENUE

- 8.1 The race office is located at the UYCNs on following address: Seegelände 4, 7100 Neusiedl/See, Austria.
- 8.2 Attachment A shows the location of the regatta harbour and racing areas.

9 THE COURSES

The course to be sailed will be specified in the Sailing Instructions.

10 SCORING

- 12.1 Nine Races are planded. Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

13 PRIZES

There will be prizes for the top 3. Each Sailor will get a giveaway at the prizegiving.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 per event or the equivalent.
